Hanyu 2000 Five of Spades #9601 is a unique and highly sought-after bottle. Produced by the Hanyu distillery in Japan, this single malt whisky was distilled in the year 2000 and bottled in 2008. With a high alcohol content of 60.5 %, it promises a robust and flavorful experience. Only 632 bottles were ever produced, making it a rare find for collectors and enthusiasts.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from November 2016, when the price was around 2 768 €. Over the last year, the cost of this bottle has increased by 87.6 % - from 8 148 € to the current market value, which is 15 176 €.

The bottle can currently be purchased in a Japanese e-store for 21 445 €. One live auction is now underway and ends on June 5. The whisky was last auctioned in January 2022 for 8 153 €.






Another remarkable release from Hanyu is the <u>1988 Queen of Clubs American Oak Finish #7003</u>. This Japanese single-malt whisky was distilled in 1988 and bottled in 2008, offering a glimpse into the past. With an alcohol content of 56 %, it presents a delightful balance of flavors. Aged for 20 years, this bottle offers a limited release of 2 000 bottles, making it a treasured find for whisky enthusiasts.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from March 2015, when the price was around 733 €. Over the last year, the cost of this bottle has increased by 130.5 % - from 4 255 € to the current market value, which is 9 745 €.

The bottle can currently be purchased in a Japanese e-store for 11 465 € and a Dutch e-store for 8 500 €. Unfortunately, any online auction is presently running. The whisky was last auctioned in September 2022 for 4 857 €.






The Yoichi 1988 Single Cask Warehouse #25 Virgin Oak Butt #100215 LMDW is an exceptional choice for those who appreciate the complexity of single cask expressions. Distilled in 1988 and bottled in 2013 by Nikka's Yoichi distillery, this 25-year-old single malt whisky showcases the influence of virgin oak barrels. With an impressive alcohol content of 62 %, this limited edition release comprises only 427 bottles.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from December 2014, when the price was around 468 €. Over the last year, the cost of this bottle has increased by 21.7 % - from 3 937 € to the current market value, which is 5 272 €.

The bottle can currently be purchased in an Italian e-store for 9 638 €. Unfortunately, any online auction is presently running. The whisky was last auctioned in February 2023 for 2 600 € and April 2023 for 3 000 €.







Stepping outside Japan, The Lakes Distillery presents <u>The Whiskymaker's Reserve</u> #1 Cask Strength PX & Red Wine Oak Casks. Crafted in the United Kingdom, this expression reflects the distillery's dedication to quality. Bottled in 2019 at a potent 60.6%, this bottle features a unique combination of Pedro Ximénez and red wine oak cask maturation. Its limited production of 5 922 bottles offers a distinctive taste experience.

Our earliest data on this bottle is from October 2019, when the price was around 61 €. Over the last year, the cost of this bottle has increased by 89.3 % - from 563 € to the current market value, which is 1 075 €.

The bottle can currently be purchased in the UK e-stores where the price ranges from 1 727 € to 2 188 €. One live auction is now underway and ends on May 28. The whisky was last auctioned in May 2023 when the price ranged from 744 € to 918 €.





The bottle can currently be purchased in the UK e-stores, where the cost ranges from 345 € to 380 €. Unfortunately, any online auction is presently running. The whisky was last auctioned in May 2023 for 161 €.





Following the success of the 4th release, the <u>Kilkerran Work in Progress 6th Release Sherry</u> continues to showcase Glengyle's dedication to quality. Bottled in 2014, this 46% expression presents a sherry influence on the palate and offers whisky enthusiasts an opportunity to explore the distillery's sherry cask maturation techniques. Limited to 9 000 bottles, it has garnered attention for its distinctive character.
